

328 responses collected by YouGov 10/12 - 10/20 2023

Sampling frame: politically representative "modeled frame" of Maine adults, based upon the American Community Survey (ACS) public use microdata file, public voter file records, the 2020 Current Population Survey (CPS) Voting and Registration supplements, the 2020 National Election Pool (NEP) exit poll, and the 2020 CES surveys, including demographics and 2020 presidential vote.
